## Initial IMO strategy on the reduction of GHG emissions from ships

### Vision:

IMO remains committed to reducing GHG emissions from international shipping and, as a matter of urgency, aims to phase them out as soon as possible in this century

**IMO is targeting to reduce the total annual GHG emissions by at least 50% by 2050 compared to 2008**
